Badger Honor Flight GUARDIAN KEY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

This is your primary job!

- 1. **SAFETY** is our main concern. Assist the Veterans in getting around the airports, on and off the bus, and around the memorials. You will have to watch some Veterans closer than others. Be particularly alert for this toward the end of the day when fatigue is high.
- 2. **NEVER** leave your Veteran unaccompanied!
- 3. **INFORM** your Bus Captain or Medical Staff immediately if any Veteran has a medical issue. Including but not limited to a fall, complaining of fatigue, chest pain, shortness of breath, dizziness, or seems confused. Watch for symptoms some Veterans will not tell you until it is too late!
- 4. **CHECK** the bus, airplane, waiting areas, and wherever the Veterans sit, to make sure that they do not accidentally leave their wallet, glasses, cell phone, camera, etc. behind.
- 5. **LISTEN** and provide a sympathetic ear.
- 6. **DO NOT** stray from the group. Stay at the memorial currently being visited.
- 7. You should encourage them to drink plenty of fluids and eat throughout the day. Inform them that bathrooms are available on the airplane, on the bus, at the memorials and throughout the airports. Personal hygiene items (wipes, Depends, etc) are also available to Veterans and Guardians.
