We are currently accepting applications from Veterans who served from World War II through Vietnam era, or TLC Veterans from any conflict (TLC = Their Last Chance – Goto our website for more information/criteria)

### Eligibility Requirements:

- 1) We are only accepting applications from Veterans who served from December 7, 1941 to May 7, 1975
- 2) Conflict Service Dates:  
World War II: Dec 7, 1941 – Dec 31, 1946  
Korea: Jun 25, 1950 – Jan 31, 1955  
Vietnam: Nov 1, 1955 – May 7, 1975
- 3) Served anywhere during this time in the US Military
- 4) Served on Active Duty or in the Reserves or in the National Guard

Our priority is to fly World War II, Korean, and TLC Veterans first and then our Vietnam War Veterans
